

## AGREEMENT FOR PATRONAGE AND TRAINING

BETWEEN

The Master in Human Development and Food Security – with headquarters in Rome, Via Ostiense 139, hereinafter referred to as “the Promoter”, represented by Professor Pasquale De Muro

AND

The Organization Nutrition & Food Safety and wholesomeness. Prevention, education and research network - NOODLES.onlus

NOODLES focuses its activities on i) the prevention of health risks for the present generation and burden of poor health for generations to come; ii) defence of typical food production chains and food self-sufficiency. NOODLES supports the integration between food safety and security strategies

hereinafter referred to as “the Host Organization”, represented, in legal terms, by Dr. Chiara Frazzoli

GIVEN

that in order to link the world of research and university with that of organizations operating in the field of development, it is necessary to establish preferential channels for communication and exchange of ideas and competences, and given the importance of a mutual recognition of their respective activities;

that the partnership between the master and the organizations operating in the field of development could represent an outstanding opportunity for both parties to increase their respective potentials significantly both in terms of knowledge and in terms of reciprocal contributions. Among the different contributions that such an exchange could comprise, is the possibility of training of participants in the master’s course, which on the one hand would allow the participant to accumulate experience useful for his/her professional growth and on the other hand would allow the Host Organization to receive adequate support for its mission or project objectives.

The following is stipulated

Art. 1

The Promoter commits to advertise the partnership on its website and in official publications related to the promotion of both the master and research. The Host Organization also commits to advertise the partnership on its website and in publications related to themes that are closely linked to the master or to contributions provided by the trainee.

Art. 2

The Host Organization can decide to receive one or more participants of the master's course as a trainee (or trainees) according to the Organization availability in terms of human resources and actual professional activities to be carried out. Thus it is important that each trainee could gain a working experience that will improve his/her professional skills effectively. Furthermore, the traineeship period suggested is three months and it can be extended according to the needs of the Host Organization.

The Host Organization decides whether to recompense the expenses of the trainee(s) or whether the traineeship is to be carried out on a voluntary basis. The insurance of the trainee(s) during the period of the traineeship will be paid for by the Host Organization.

#### Art. 3

The Host Organization can offer to give lectures that are related both to the master topics and to organization's goals. These lectures and topics can be agreed between the Host Organization and the coordinator of the master. Furthermore the Host Organization can provide study materials such as organization's publications, data and working papers.

#### Art. 4

The present Agreement lasts for one year from the date of signature and can be extended for the same, abovementioned, period by written agreement between the parties. The Promoter organization commit themselves not to use the patronage for lucrative or commercial purposes.

No financial obligations are foreseen for the parties.
